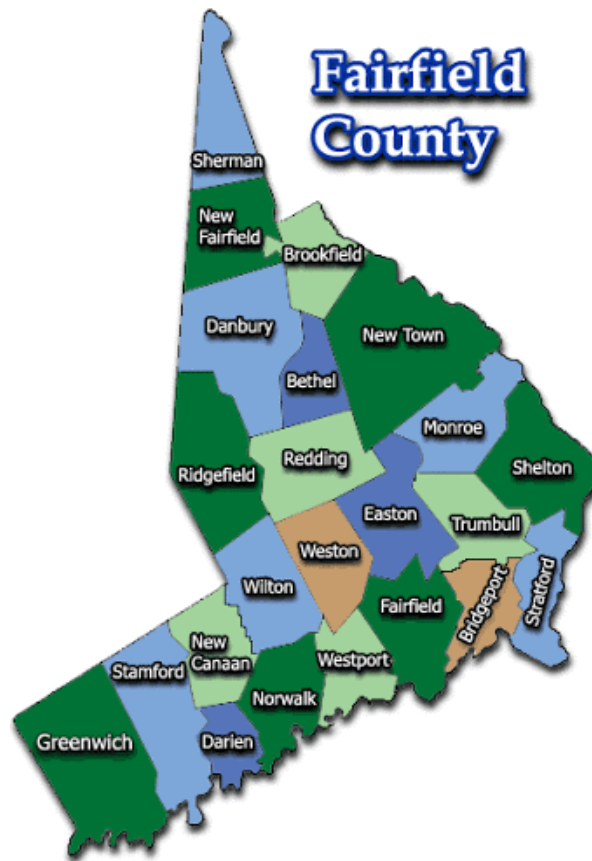


Fairfield County FIVE:
